

# What you need to know

# **Pre-stay information**

#### **Location and Entrance:**

Come through the main entrance for Burleigh Court Cotswolds Restaurant & Hotel. Burleigh Lodge is located just to the right upon entering. The separate lodge entrance is accessible through a hedge to the right, which is a little narrow, so reversing in or turning around in the hotel car park might be helpful. Please avoid parking in the hotel car park as it is reserved for hotel guests. There is one parking space on the level of the property through the hedge and additional free parking outside on the lanes.

#### **Check-in and Check-out:**

Check-in is typically between 3 PM and 9 PM. Please collect your keys from our friendly hotel reception and return them there upon check-out by 10.30 AM on your departure day.

# **Kitchen and Amenities:**

The kitchen is fully equipped and includes a starter kit with dishwasher tablets, sponge, washing machine tabs, washing up liquid, and dishtowels. The Nespresso machine will have a few pods, and there will be some tea and milk to get you started. Please bring your own supplies of sugar, salt, etc. Shampoo and shower gel are not provided, but a hairdryer and hand soap are available.

## **Appliances and Hot Tub:**

A manual for operating appliances and the hot tub will be available upon check-in. The hot tub is wood-fired and takes about 3 hours to heat up. It can be used between 9 AM and 9 PM. There is enough wood for moderate use, but if you plan to use it frequently, please bring additional supplies. Firewood and fire lighters are available at nearby home stores and petrol stations.

# Parking:

There are two parking spaces: one off-street on the lodge's private drive and another outside on the lane in front of the garden entrance.

# Navigation:

For best results, set your navigation destination to Burleigh Court Cotswolds on Google Maps or Waze, as postcodes may not work reliably in this area.

#### **Dining Options:**

The hotel/restaurant offers excellent lunch, afternoon tea and dinner and is renowned for its local Cotswolds larder cuisine. You are welcome to make a <u>reservation there for dining</u>.

## **Best Route:**

The recommended route is via Cirencester Road/Minchinhampton, depending on your starting location.

## **House Rules:**

Upon departure, please ensure the house is tidy with all kitchen items cleaned and stored away. Empty the bins in the house and place them in the large bins on the drive. Furniture should not be moved, and if you encounter any issues, please notify me promptly so they can be addressed. Refund claims will not be accepted if issues are not reported during your stay.
